NIEMANN WINS IN G440 DEBUT

In the G440 family's first week on tours, Joaquín Niemann employed the G440 LST driver and G440 3-wood to maximum effect, winning the Asian Tour's PIF Saudi International. With the title he won the International Series Rankings race.

Niemann was one of a number of players who switched to G440, including Tyrrell Hatton, who finished fifth in Saudi Arabia.

Niemann also relied on a G430 hybrid, Blueprint S irons, s159 wedges and a PLD Custom Anser putter.
