



TAKING CHARGE

With a G440 LST driver and G440 MAX 4W and 7W in the bag, Logan McAllister not only made the most of “moving day” on Saturday, he continued his charge to the top of the leaderboard on Sunday. He went 15-under (63-64) on the weekend, best in the field by four strokes, enroute to winning his first Korn Ferry Tour title at the Astara Chile Classic in Santiago, Chile.

The Oklahoma University alum jumped to sixth on the KFT points list.

In addition to the G440 driver and fairways, McAllister relied on Blueprint S irons, s159 wedges, and a PLD Prime Tyne putter. See his What’s In The Bag, next page.

McAllister’s win was the sixth for the G440 LST driver in the last four weeks.

18 STAFFERS PRIMED FOR THE PLAYERS

Corey Conners, fresh off a third at the Arnold Palmer Invitational, will be joined by Harris English and Brian Campbell, both winners this season, plus Sahith Theegala, Viktor Hovland, Tony Finau and 12 more PING pros at The Players Championship that starts Thursday.

Conners jumped 20 places to 30th in the world ranking with his showing in Orlando.

Laurie Canter, who last month posted his second win on the DP World Tour, is among those at TPC Sawgrass chasing the

Rasmus Neergaard-Petersen made quite the first impression in his first-ever PGA Tour start. On Sunday at the Puerto Rico Open, relying on a G440 LST driver and G440 MAX 3W, he made three birdies on the front and reeled off six straight to start the back on his way to a 9-under 63, low round of the day, earning him a second-place finish. His performance follows a runner-up in Qatar on the DP World Tour, where he has two more top 10s this season. He had three victories last season on the HotelPlanner Tour to earn his promotion to the DP World Tour.
